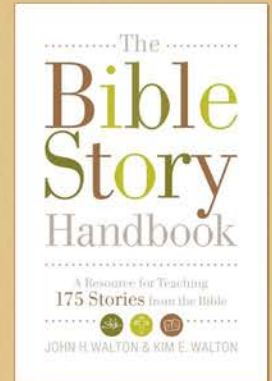

**August 14 at 7pm**

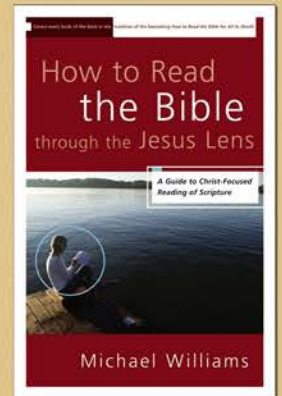
